Charge of the Committee:

1. Provide leadership in the review, evaluation, and use of data for continuous improvement and accountability for student growth and development and unit assessment plans.
2. Ensure consensus about what the institution expects students to represent or demonstrate along the continuum of their development.
3. Monitor assessment of student growth and development outcomes in areas related to student affairs, athletics, and student leadership.
4. Determine how to integrate data collected for continuous improvement and accountability among areas related to student affairs, athletics, and student leadership.
5. Use the assessment results to verify student growth and development and to identify patterns of weakness in order to improve services.
6. Determine how outputs in the form of products, services, and information will be received and measured by students.
7. Provide an annual report to the Assessment Oversight Committee documenting changes, strengths, and weaknesses of educational support services and student affairs.
8. Disseminate results of assessment of educational support services and student affairs in order to inform the budget process.
