General Information

The Tennessee Governor's Schools offer Tennessee high school students intensive learning experiences virtually or on postsecondary campuses. Each school system is encouraged to share the Governor's School information and applications with strong students who meet the criteria listed below. Nominations for the Tennessee Governor's Schools must be made by high school educators who can speak to the student's potential for success in the program. Each Governor's School convenes an application review committee to select the students invited to attend each school.

Governor's School for the Humanities The University of Tennessee at Martin

June 1-June 27

Building on the program's rich tradition as Tennessee's first Governor's School, the 2025 Governor's School for the Humanities (GSH) will offer students the opportunity to earn three semester credit hours from the University of Tennessee at Martin. Three additional, non-credit academic enrichment courses will be offered. While the exact schedule of courses has not been finalized, past offerings have traditionally focused on communications, English, history, international relations, philosophy and political science. The academic program, which will feature a lineup of award-winning university professors, will be augmented by a variety of co-curricular activities in areas such as journalism, theatre and desktop publishing. The faculty and staff look forward to once again providing an unmatched intellectual experience on one of Tennessee's most beautiful and supportive campuses. As with any humanities program in which university credit is offered, students should expect rigorous reading and writing loads.

Prerequisites: Applicants should have excellent records in English classes and be able to demonstrate advanced experience in creative writing and literary analysis. Rising juniors and seniors may apply (current high school sophomores and juniors), but strong preference will be given to rising seniors. Submissions of ACT and other standardized test scores are recommended in order to provide evidence of the student's likelihood of succeeding at the university level. Those students invited to attend will receive instructions on completing the UT Martin application process after accepting GSH invitations. University admission requirements include an official high school transcript (with a school seal and school official signature); parental and high school permissions to attend; and a minimum cumulative 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale.

Application deadline: December 6, 2024

Submitting the Application:

Nominating educators should electronically submit completed applications following directions provided by the respective Governor's School(s). Applications submitted directly by students will **not** be accepted. The student may keep a copy of the application, excluding the confidential *Teacher Reference* forms and the confidential *Counselor/Administrator Verification* form; the nominating educator should keep one complete copy of the submitted application package.

Application Submission Instructions

Ensure applications are complete, arranged in the correct order, and contain all required signatures and documents as outlined below.

- 1. Nominating educators must submit applications electronically no later than the deadline(s) listed on page two of each application.
- 2. Each Governor's School has specific essay and writing sample questions. All questions must be answered and submitted online or with the application packet.
- Class rank, class size, numerical test scores, etc., (if available) must be verified by the school counselor or school administrator. Please note that while PSAT, SAT and ACT scores are not mandatory, school administrators are strongly encouraged to include this information if available.
- 4. Students are to list two teachers (see school-specific list) to complete the confidential *Teacher's Reference* forms. If the teacher is not the faculty member nominating the student, he/she should return the completed reference forms directly to the nominating educator. There is a space available at the bottom of the teacher reference form to put the name of the school personnel to whom the form is to be returned.
- 5. An official transcript must be included in the application packet or uploaded online.
- 6. A personal photo is not required but is an optional submission document.

- 2. Provide a typed description, in no more than 200 words, of an experience that stimulated the applicant's intellectual interest in applying for this school. This might include a classroom discussion, relationship encounter, family situation, unanswered value challenge or moral dilemma.
- 3. Provide a one-page, typed resume of activities, achievements, work experience and volunteer or community service work.

Please note: The screening committee will only review applications that meet these requirements. Students who are accepted typically present superior standardized test scores, outstanding academic records, strong reference letters, clear writing talent, and an extensive record of school and community service.
